



## Party Tip Sheet

1. Book your party entertainer before you settle on a date. There is nothing worse than finding the perfect performer for your party to find that he/she has no availability on that day.
2. Put a "RSVP by" date on your invitations- it will help gauge numbers early on.
3. Include your full address, postcode and helpful directions with the invitation.
4. Plan your party with your child they love being involved in the process.
5. Ask your entertainer advice if your not sure about any aspect of the party or their performance. I do hundreds of shows a year and love to help out in anyway I can. It makes both my job and yours much easier if we all know what we expect from each other.
6. If you decided to do the game section of the party yourself try not to play elimination games or if you do decided to play them sweeten the blow with a treat for the kids that get put out like giving them a sweetie or a lolly.
7. I find putting sticky labels with there name on them as they come in will help you to control the children better as you will probably not know all the kids by there first name.
8. If it's a house party attach some balloons to your gate or front door sometimes the parents forget to lift the invitation and wander aimlessly around your street until some other sensible party attendee turns up with the exact address.
9. Keep food simple the kids are so excited to be there the food is a bonus. I recommend mini pizzas sausage rolls, cheesy puffs, (sausage rolls but with cheese instead) diluting juice and few sweets.
